## MReader via a Moodle Link

For those who have a Moodle system, but for various reasons cannot install the Moodle “reader” plug-in, the following method allows students to access MReader from within a course page in order to take quizzes or view their current status.

To do so, follow the procedure below.

- 1) Register a standard MReader site with the student IDs identical to those used on their local Moodle site. (The MReader prefix, of course, is only registered on the MReader side.)
- 2) Send a request to [admin@mreader.org](mailto:admin@mreader.org) specifying:
  - The URL of your Moodle
  - The short name(s) of the course(s) in which you intend to embed a link to MReader
- 3) Set up the link in the following manner:
  - External URL: <https://mreader.org/quicklogin.php>
  - Appearance: (These may be changed to suit the student screen)
    - Display → In pop-up
    - Pop-up width: 1200px
    - Pop-up height: 800px
  - URL variables:
    - username → Username
    - course → Course short name
- 4) Note that this only works for students, not teachers or the site admin. Please create a dummy student account for yourself in order to test it.
